

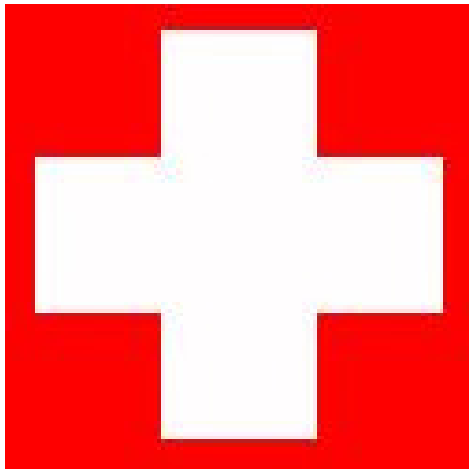
# The Eski Prize
